

You Have Constitutional Rights:

Vous disposez de droits constitutionnels :

- **DO NOT OPEN THE DOOR** if an immigration agent is knocking. If you are inside of your house, show the card through the window or slide it under the door.
- **DO NOT ANSWER ANY QUESTIONS** from an immigration agent if they try to talk to you. You have the right to remain silent.
- **DO NOT SIGN ANYTHING** without first speaking to a lawyer. You have the right to speak with a lawyer.
- If you are outside of your house, **SHOW THIS CARD TO THE AGENT**. Ask the agent if you are free to leave and if they say you can, leave calmly.
- **N'OUVREZ PAS LA PORTE** si un agent de l'immigration frappe. Si vous êtes à l'intérieur de votre domicile, montrez cette carte par la fenêtre ou glissez-la sous la porte.
- **NE RÉPONDEZ À AUCUNE QUESTION** posée par un agent de l'immigration s'il tente de vous parler. Vous avez le droit de garder le silence.
- **NE SIGNEZ RIEN** sans avoir d'abord consulté un avocat. Vous avez le droit de consulter un avocat.
- Si vous êtes à l'extérieur de votre domicile, **MONTREZ CETTE CARTE À L'AGENT**. Demandez à l'agent si vous êtes libre de partir et, s'il vous dit que oui, partez calmement.

I do not wish to speak with you, answer your questions, or sign or hand you any documents based on my 5th Amendment rights under the United States Constitution.

I do not give you permission to enter my home based on my 4th Amendment rights under the United States Constitution unless you have a warrant to enter, signed by a judge or magistrate with my name on it that you slide under the door.

I do not give you permission to search any of my belongings based on my 4th Amendment rights. I choose to exercise my constitutional rights.

These cards are available to citizens and noncitizens alike.
